# RaiseRight™

All Scrip on line orders made through RaiseRight need to be submitted/ ordered by **December 8th** to guarantee they will be received in time for Christmas, any orders placed after December 8 cannot be guaranteed to arrive on time.

**How do I order Scrip?** Use Your Cell Phone and/or Computer!

Raise Right allows you to purchase scrip directly from your phone or home computer. Scrip can be loaded directly to your phone by downloading the **myscripwallet** app, or can be printed from a computer.

The St. Bernadette enrollment code is: 9D5F3CF55849.

At this point you should be able to order directly from your phone and receive gift cards within minutes.

Scrip is also sold at the parish office Monday through Thursday 8:30 am-4:00 pm and Friday 8:30 am- 12:30 pm.
