Our middle school students continue to lead our school's community service projects – and look forward to collecting diapers for <u>Westside Baby</u> who serves families with children in need. We will offer summer care for our youngest students, ages 2 1/2 - 5 years old (pre-school through students entering kindergarten) and potty-trained, this summer. **Only 5 spots remain!** Please go here to register for summer care. IMPORTANT PARENT VOLUNTEER HOUR INFORMATION

To support the school and get to know the community better, all St. Bernadette School families are required to give 25 hours of service as part of the Parent Club Contract that each family signs during the enrollment process.

Hours may be completed at the school or parish, from August 1, 2023 through May 24, 2024. Hours not completed are billed at **\$25** per hour in June through your Finalsite billing account.

Statements reflecting the amount of hours each family has submitted were sent home on December 13th and March 18th. Please contact <u>parentclubestbernadettesea.org</u> if you need an update on the hours you have submitted thus far.

Hours must be completed and submitted by May 24, 2024 in order to avoid being charged. Please note, hours completed at the Bite of Bernadette on June 1 will count towards the 2024-2025 school year.

- Poorly controlled asthma
- Resident of King County
- 5 years old or older
